



CLEANING

Clean your motorcycle regularly to protect the surface finishes and inspect for damage, wear, and oil or brake fluid leakage.

CAUTION:

*** High pressure water (or air) can damage certain parts of the motorcycle.**

Avoid spraying high pressure water (typical in coin-operated car washes) at the following areas:

- Wheel Hubs
- Ignition Switch
- Carburetor
- Brake Master Cylinder
- Instruments
- Handlebar Switches
- Muffler Outlet
- Under Fuel Tank
- Drive Chain
- Under Seat
- Headlight

1. After cleaning, rinse the motorcycle thoroughly with plenty of clean water. Strong detergent residue can corrode alloy parts.

NOTE:

- * Clean the headlight lens, meter lens and other plastic parts using a cloth or sponge dampened with a solution of mild detergent and water. Rub the soiled area gently rinsing it frequently with fresh water.
